

**OPTION 1 PLEAD NO CONTEST OR GUILTY & PAY IN FULL**

**APPEAR BY MAIL** – Submit your payment & plea by mail (not applicable to juveniles) OR online at <https://www.municipalonlinepayments.com/banderatx>

**PLEA OPTIONS: Choose one and sign your name**

(  ) I enter a plea of **No Contest and** waive my right to a jury trial. *This selection means that you do not contest the State’s charge(s) against you but are not admitting guilt and agree to pay the fine/costs assessed by the Judge.*

**OPTION 2 PLEAD NOT GUILTY & REQUEST A PRE-TRIAL**

To contest a citation and plead NOT guilty, you must request a Pre-Trial Hearing in person, or by mail, on or before your appearance date. You may retain an attorney, who should then submit a letter of representation to the Court by your appearance date. Court hearings cannot be scheduled by phone. Check the Plea box, sign your name and mail or bring to the Court.

(  ) I enter a plea of **NOT guilty** and request a trial.

This selection means that you intend to contest the charge(s) against you. Your case will be rescheduled for a Pre-trial and you will be mailed notice of when to appear for the pre-trial conference.

**OPTION 3 REQUEST A DRIVING COURSE**

**Take a course, pay a reduced fee to Court, receive a dismissal**

**A request for this option must be made by your appearance date. Driving Course will not be granted after the response date.** You Must Meet ALL Eligibility Requirements:

- You are at least 17 years of age.
- You do not possess a Commercial Driver’s License.
- You have current liability insurance & a valid Texas Driver’s License.
- You are not charged with speeding more than 24 miles per hour over the speed limit and the violation did not occur in a construction zone.
- You have not taken a Driving Course within the last 12 months.
- 

The following items **must** be submitted to the court on or before the appearance date shown on the citation to be eligible to take the course:

1. Submit the NOTARIZED affidavit below.
2. Court Costs of \$109.00, or \$134.00 (for school zone violations).
3. Copy of your Texas driver’s license and current proof of insurance, listing you as a covered driver.

1) Proof of completion of the course and 2) a certified copy of my driving record as maintained by the Texas Dept. of Public Safety (3A version) <https://www.dps.texas.gov/DriverLicense/driverrecords.htm> I further understand that I am eligible to request a Driving Safety Course for only one violation at a time. My failure to comply with the terms of this request will result in assessment of a fine and possible conviction on my driving record.

**OPTION**

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**REQUEST DEFERRED DISPOSITION**

**A 90-day probationary period & pay full fine + \$30 dismissal fee**

You are eligible for DEFERRED DISPOSITION if:

- You have a current liability insurance & are listed on the policy as a driver.
- You have a valid Driver's License.
- You are at least 17 years of Age.
- You do not have a CDL license currently or at the time of offense.
- You have not received any citation for a moving violation during the past 6 months within the State of Texas.
- You are not currently participating in a Deferred Disposition in any court.
- You are not charged with speeding in excess of 24 mph over the limit, nor in a construction zone.

**TO REQUEST IN PERSON:** Bring your driver's license, proof of insurance (for policy listing you as a driver), and payment to the Court service window during business hours.

**TO REQUEST BY MAIL:** If eligible, you may request this option by providing the following three (3) items to the Municipal Court by mail.

1. The completed request Form below.
2. Payment: Fines (fees) for each violation listed on the inside of this brochure **plus a \$30.00 deferral fee** or you may call the Court for current amounts due at 1-830-796-3456.
3. A copy of your current insurance policy which list you as a driver.

**MAIL REQUEST FORM – Deferred Disposition**

I wish to enter a plea of  Guilty  No Contest on Citation \_\_\_\_\_
